2. Animals to arrive on the grounds between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Mon., 8/18.
3. Market classes will be at 9 a.m. Tue., 8/19.
4. Championship market beef classes immediately after the final market class.
5. Fitting & Showing classes will take place at 9 a.m. Wed, 8/20.
6. Market beef will be weighed between 1 and 7 p.m. Mon., 8/18.
7. Blocking chutes to be put in designated area. Hair clipping and grooming equipment must be picked up.

All 4-H and FFA beef exhibitors must enter and exhibit in Fitting and Showing to be eligible for any premium points. **Be sure to mark Fitting and Showing on entry form or it will be returned. Champion showmen will compete in the Round Robin on Thursday, 08/21.**
