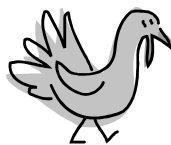

All exhibitors will be required to sign a release form regarding their birds health before their fowl will be allowed in the building.

1. Before entering, refer to General Information, Livestock Rules and Regulations and Youth Rules.
2. Birds to arrive on the grounds between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. Mon., 8/18. Birds to leave the grounds between 8 and 10 a.m. Sun., 8/24. Superintendents and fair NOT responsible for birds left after 10 a.m.
3. LIMIT: Two entries per variety, per age, per sex (i.e. 2 Rhode Island Red cockerels, 2 Rhode Island Red cocks, 2 Rhode Island red young trio, etc.), not to exceed 12 total entries. No limit on Class J. Eggs.
4. Birds will be judged Tue., 8/19.
5. Fitting and showing will be held Tue., 8/19. Seniors and FFA at 4 p.m. Intermediate and Juniors to follow. Fitting and Showing winners will advance to the Small Animal Round Robin at 5 p.m., Wed. 8/20. All exhibitors must enter fitting and showing in order to receive premium points.
6. All exhibitors must sign up for barn duty times during the fair. Herdsmanship includes the entire barn. All exhibitors must keep their animals, barn area, and grooming area clean or premium monies will be withheld. Cages must be cleaned by 9 a.m. daily.
7. Exhibitors must provide their own feed for the entire week. Superintendents are not responsible for providing or caring for supplies or equipment.
8. There will be a poultry auction at noon Fri., 8/22. Exhibitors wishing to sell in the Poultry Auction must pick-up a form from the superintendent at time of check-in and return it by 10 p.m. Wed., 8/20.

FITTING AND SHOWING

4-H and FFA members MUST exhibit in Fitting and Showing to be eligible for any premium points. Be sure to mark Fitting and Showing on the entry form or it will be returned. Champion showmen will compete in the Round Robin on Wednesday.

D. Meat chickens - All breeds of birds judged for meat production. ***List weight and age on the cage tag.***

E. Egg production - All breeds of chicken judged for their capability to produce eggs. ***Must list young or old on the cage tag.***

PEE WEE SHOWNMANSHIP

Sign-up on Mon., 8/18 at the poultry barn. For children not old enough to be in 4-H. Also includes primary level 4-Hers. Animals must already be entered in either open class or 4-H and must be on grounds.

NOTE: No premiums paid in this class.

AUCTION RULES

1. Auction is open to 4-H Junior, Intermediate, and Seniors exhibiting in Dept. 37 (Pigeons, Game Birds and Cage birds) and Dept. 38 (Poultry).
2. To enter the auction, exhibitor must pick up an entry form at the poultry superintendent office and return it to the superintendents before 10 p.m. Wed., 8/20.
3. Each exhibitor will be limited to three lots, but a lot may be single, pair, or trio.
4. The birds may be sold as meat birds, egg producers, or breeders.
5. The entries will be sold by the lot, regardless of the number of birds in it.
6. Birds sold must be exhibited and judged at the fair.
7. Each exhibitor may only sell birds shown in his/her name.
8. Exhibitor must show birds at sale time or make arrangements for help.
9. To cover the cost of checks and postage, .50 cents will be deducted from each seller's total.
10. Birds sold at the auction will be released from 8-10 a.m. Sun., 8/24 unless special arrangements have been made with the superintendent.
