

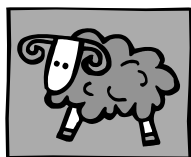
**DEPARTMENT 40
4-H AND FFA SHEEP**

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ASSISTANT:
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1. Before entering, refer to General Information, Livestock Rules and Regulations, Youth and Market Stock Rules.
2. Animals to arrive on the grounds and be weighed Mon., 8/18, between noon and 7 p.m. No wet or damp lambs across the scale. Halters and leads off. No lambs in pens before that time.
3. Market classes will be held 9 a.m. Tue., 8/19. Breeding classes to follow.
4. Fitting and Showing to be held at 9 a.m., Wed 8/20.
5. Lambs are not to be washed at the fair. Only spot washing of manure stains will be allowed.
6. No private scales will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
7. Superior Farms requires all lambs (ewes and wethers) to have USDA or WSDA Scrapie Eradication flock identification. To obtain a number, call the USDA: 866-873-2824.

FITTING AND SHOWING

Exhibitors must enter and exhibit in Fitting and Showing to be eligible for any premium points. Be sure to mark Fitting and Showing on the entry form or it will be returned. Grand Champion Showmen will compete in the Round Robin on Thurs., 8/21.

Lambs must have been born after 1/01/08. Lambs must be slick shorn between 7/15 and 7/31/08 to be eligible for Market Classes and tagged on 5/17/08 before arrival at grounds.
