1. Before entering, refer to General Information and Youth Rules.
2. Dogs to arrive on the grounds at 8 a.m. Sat., 8/23.
3. Dogs will be benched from 9 a.m. until close of the dog show.
4. All dogs must be kept on a leash, except during the competition.
5. No dog shall be left unattended. Dogs are not allowed outside the immediate vicinity of the dog show area.
6. Any dog causing problems will be disqualified and excused from the fairgrounds.
7. Bitches in season must wear doggy britches at all times while at the fair, except when caged or while in the exercise yard. They may not show in obedience class.
8. ONLY out-of-state animals must have official health certificates showing freedom from infection or communicable disease within 30 days. Dogs MUST be vaccinated against rabies, distemper, infection hepatitis, parainfluenza and parvo virus. Any dog without proof of vaccinations will be excused from the fairgrounds. NO EXCEPTIONS.
9. Dogs may not be entered in an obedience/rally class in which they have completed AKC degree qualifications. AKC rules will be the guide, but not the absolute. No dogs under 6 months of age may be exhibited.
10. Baiting will be allowed in Fitting and Showing. At no time will an exhibitor be allowed to bait his or her dog in an obedience class.
11. The youth show will be judged on the Danish system.
12. Dog Bowl and Dog Judging will be held on 8/14 beginning at 9 a.m. in the Hospitality tent. NO dogs allowed, no exceptions.

FITTING AND SHOWING

Exhibitors must enter and exhibit in Fitting and Showing to be eligible for any premium points. Be sure to mark Fitting and Showing on the entry form or it will be returned.
