1. Before entering, refer to General Information & Youth Rules. Entry forms are due 8/01/07 to fair office. Be sure to enter both Class A: Modeling and B: Consumer Knowledge. Late entries will not be accepted. Contestants must provide their own commentator for the Fashion Show, Wed., 8/20. Detailed Creative Consumer of Fashion requirements will be available from the Franklin County Extension Office in early July. Contact your leader or the Extension Office at 545-3511 for details. Contestants make an appointment for judging time by calling the superintendent on the above listed number Aug. 8-15.
2. Judging will be held on Wed., Aug. 20, in the 4-H building on the stage. Contact the superintendent for an appointment.
3. After judging is completed on Wed., a public Fashion Show will be held at 5:30 p.m. in the 4-H building. Contestants must check in at 5 p.m. for pictures and line-up.
4. Garment and ribbon check-in is immediately following the Fashion Show in the 4-H building.
5. Creative Consumer of Fashion is open to all qualified 4-H members. It is divided into two separate classes. Each class requires a separate entry on the fair entry form. Contestants must compete in both classes to earn premium points. In Class A, the contestant will be judged for garment fit, accessory selection and modeling skills. In Class B, the contestant is judged for consumer knowledge such as the outfit's suitability for the intended purpose, whether the garments form a versatile part of the wardrobe, maintenance of the garments, etc.
 - a. The outfit consists of garments and accessories purchased by the contestant and/or remodeled or recycled clothing. Complete data sheets, photos, etc., must be provided.
 - b. Each separate piece must have a permanently attached care label or 3" x 5" card with care instructions.
 - c. All sleepwear made for children through size 12 must be made of flame-retardant fabrics.
 - d. All judging of these activities will be done on stage before the public. This includes both modeling and interview judging.
6. The contestant must participate in the modeling judging, interview judging and fashion show, and display their garments for the balance of the fair to be able to earn premium points.
7. LIMIT: One entry per contestant.
