1. Before entering, refer to General Information.
2. Exhibits must be delivered to Ice Harbor Brewing Company, 206 N. Benton St., Kennewick, between Mon., 8/11 and Fri., 8/15.
3. Judging will be held Sat., 8/16.
4. Must be 21 or older to enter this department.
5. Submit 3 bottles of beer for each category, two for tasting and one for display. **All beers become the property of the Mid-Columbia Zymurgy Association and will not be returned.**
6. Bottles shall be brown or green, 11 oz. to 16 oz., with caps painted or marked black. Entries with manufacturer's original bottle label or raised glass logos will not be accepted.
7. Bottles must carry the name of the brewer, address, lot (ale, lager, specialty) and BJCP category. Include the type of fruit or herb, if used, with the bottle information. See # 11 for BJCP category information. The label shall be secured to the bottle with rubberbands. Note: BJCP categories 20-28 should be entered under the specialty lot.
8. Bottles for display may be labeled with a homemade label. A copy of the recipe is also required and should be secured with a rubberband.
9. Each entrant or family is limited to 4 entries, no duplicate entries per specific style classification. Each lot is limited to a maximum of 50 entries on a first-come, first-served basis.
10. Entries will be limited to non-commercial.
11. Judging will be performed in accordance with Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP) guidelines and to the specific style description of the beer. Contact the Superintendent or the American Homebrew Association (AHA) web site for information regarding BJCP guidelines to determine the beer styles.
