1. Before entering, refer to General Information, Livestock Rules and Regulations, and Open Class Herdsmanship Contest.
2. Stall fee per animal is \$2, non-refundable and due with entry fee.
3. Animals to arrive on the grounds between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Monday, 8/18.
4. 4-H and FFA entries will be given first priority to available barn space.
5. Open class entries will be limited to **two goats per breed, per lot**, with **no more than 15** goats total entered per individual. Additional restrictions may be imposed depending upon availability of space and number of entries. Every attempt will be made at fairness to all exhibitors. All animals must be in place by 8 p.m. Monday. None will be admitted late. All animals will have a vet check, which will be the final word on the worthiness of the animal for admission to the show.
6. This is an ADGA combined show. Junior does will show after noon on Wednesday, 8/20. Senior does will show starting at 9:00 a.m. Thursday 8/21; group classes to follow. Show whites preferred. All clothing must be neat and clean.
7. All grains **MUST** be kept in tightly sealed containers.
8. All pens **MUST** be cleaned daily and properly secured (no bailing, twine wire or string).
9. Tack areas should be neat and free of clutter. Only items that directly pertain to the animals and your display should be visible. Personal items should be kept at your campsite or in a tack box.
10. Be sure to check all of your animal registrations to be sure they have been accepted by the ADGA. Be sure to check for proper tattoos before the fair.

A DOE CAN ONLY BE USED ONCE IN EACH GROUPING

10. Best udder, any doe in milk may be entered (Two or more animals must be competing. No premium, ribbon only.)
11. Senior get-of-sire, to consist of at least one milking doe.
12. Produce of dam, to consist of two does from the same dam.
13. Dam and daughter, any age female.
14. Three generations or more.
15. Breeder's herd, to consist of four does, any age, bred and owned by exhibitor.  
**One herd per exhibitor, per breed.**
16. Dairy herd, to consist of four does in milk. All must be owned by exhibitor. **One herd per exhibitor, per breed.**

**MILKING CONTEST**

Dairy goat exhibitors may draw milk. Other fair exhibitors may enter with the dairy goat owner's written permission. Exhibitor must provide goat. You may have a backup goat standing by. 4-H and FFA may not enter Open Class Milking Contest. Contestants will be judged by the most milk drawn in one minute.

**PEE WEE SHOWMANSHIP**

CONTACT SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER. For children not old enough to be in 4-H; includes primary 4-H-ers. Animals must already be entered in either open class or 4-H and be on the grounds. Contest to take place at 1 p.m. Sat., 8/23. No premiums paid; ribbon only.
