1. Before entering, refer to General Information.
2. Pre-registration will be required for entries in department by 8/1/08.
3. Exhibits to arrive on the grounds between 1 and 5 p.m. Sunday, 8/17, or between 1 and 6 p.m. Monday, 8/18. All entries must be in place by 6 p.m. Monday to be judged. Crazy critters are best entered on Monday in order to be fresh for judging.
4. Entries will be judged on the following: A. Originality B. Use of materials; C. Use of fair theme, "Ewe Ain't Seen Nothin' Yet!"
5. Scarecrows must be under six feet high.
6. Scarecrows must be constructed of agricultural or natural materials such as straw, vegetables, fruit, grains and grasses.
7. Scarecrows can be clothed in Western items, but the use of commercial items will be limited at the discretion of the Superintendent.
8. A crazy critter is an animal constructed from vegetables, nuts, fruits and/or flowers ONLY. Any other materials used to enhance the appearance of the critter (such as plastic eyes or cloth) is unacceptable. Glue and toothpicks may be used in the construction. This class is open to youth 16 and under, and will be subdivided according to age as listed.
9. A decorated pumpkin is a pumpkin, squash or gourd which has been carved, painted or otherwise altered to depict a Jack-o-Lantern, a famous character, or other work of art. It is not required that the pumpkin or squash be grown in your own garden. Dried gourds and uncarved but decorated melons are also acceptable.
